Who is eligible?

-Grades k-12 plus Transitional Programs

-Minimum of 15 students with disabilities to participate

-51% or more of participating students need to have an Individual Education Plan or a 504 Plan.

-Open to any school or educational setting within the state of Minnesota

What types of artists/art forms are available?

-Music -Theater -Visual Arts

-Creative Writing/Poetry -Dance/Movement

Goals of this program:

-To support the enhancement of creativity through unique educational arts experiences for students with disabilities and their peers.

-To develop and implement arts experiences that assist in the development of life skills, including social and communication skills, self confidence, self expression and acceptance of differences.
