Middle school students identified as having developmental cognitive disabilities and peers will be treated to a magic show, featuring the extraordinary magician, Jeffrey Smith as the **Amazing Jeffo!** Participants will be engaged in hands-on sessions exploring visual arts, music and movement with Augsburg Music Therapy students. **Amazing Jeffo** will lead a session demonstrating three magic tricks that participants can use to amaze their friends and family!

**Eligibility:** Any metro area middle school is eligible to attend this festival. Activities are designed for students identified as having developmental cognitive disabilities. Please limit student registration to 25 or less per school. Registration is first come, first serve.

**Deadline:** Wednesday, March 31, 2010 or until registration is filled.

**Cost:** This is a free event.
